DAY 01

Arrive Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu. Meet and assist at airport and transfer to hotel.

Lunch will be en route.

Dinner and overnight at hotel.

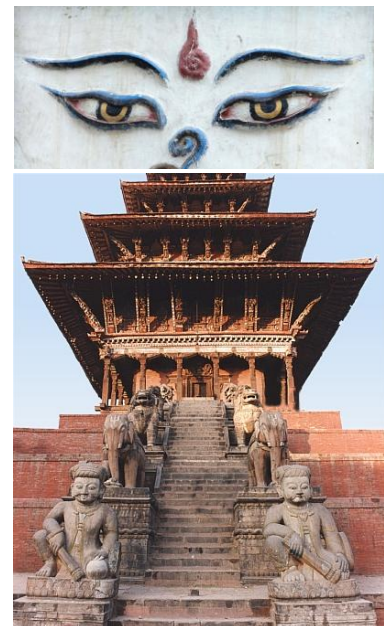
DAY 02

Kathmandu

Breakfast at hotel.

Morning proceed to full day sightseeing visiting **Pashupatinath Temple** (Temple of Lord Shiva) Pasupatinath with two tiered golden roofs and four silver doors is situated 05km east of Kathmandu at the bank of the Bagmati River. **Boudha Nath Temple** (one of the biggest in the world and is ringed by Buddhist Lamas and monasteries). **Swayambhunath Temple** - 2500 years old stupa situated on a hillock about 77m above the ground level and overlooking the Kathmandu Valley. The painted eyes on four sides represent the all seeing eyes of Buddha and are watching the good and bad that the people do.

Lunch will be en route.



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After lunch visit **Kathmandu Durbar Square** - a temple of the Living Goddess and the Old Royal Palace. All these Monuments, Pasupatinath Temple, Boudnath Temple, Swyambhunath Temple and Durbar Square are world Heritage Sites. Kathmandu Durbar Square – While browsing around Kathmandu Durbar Square you will visit **Hanuman Dhoka**, the old and historic palace of Kathmandu named after the Monkey God, Hanuman. It is a historic seat of royalty. The Kings of Nepal are crowned and their coronations also held inside the court yard. There is a statue of **King Pratap Kumari**, the residence of the Living Goddess within the vicinity. Kumari means the Virgin Girl. The girl is selected from a Buddhist family. The building has profusely carved wooden balconies and window screen.

Evening visit the **Kasthamandup** which is believed to be built from a single tree trunk and the name Kathmandu is derived from this temple.

Transfer to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 03

Kathmandu / Pokhara

Breakfast at hotel.

After breakfast drive to **Pokhara** – A place of remarkable natural beauty. The serenity of Phewa Lake and the magnificence of the fishtailed summit of Machhapuchhre (6,77m) rising behind it create an ambience of peace and magic. At an elevation lower than Kathmandu, it has a much more tropical feel to it, a fact well appreciated by the beautiful diversity of flowers which prosper in its environs. Indeed, the valley surrounding Pokhara is home to thick forests, gushing rivers, emerald lakes, and the world famous views of Himalaya. 200km west from Kathmandu drive on under the shadow of the Annapurna Himalayan range. A rare combination of snow - clad mountains, crystal clear lakes, and streams village's inhabited by friendly ethnic tribes.



On arrival at Pokhara transfer to the hotel.

Lunch at hotel.

Evening at leisure for own activities.

Dinner and over-night stay at Hotel.



DAY 04



Pokhra

Breakfast at hotel

After breakfast enjoy the **Boat Ride** on the famous **Phewa Lake** - Is the second largest lake in the Kingdom of Nepal. Nevertheless this lake is second to no one in terms of beauty. Another interesting site is the island temple in the middle.

Visit **Mahendra Caves** and **Davi's Fall** etc. Mahendra Cave - In the long queue of natural wonders in Pokhara, Mahendra Gupha or Mahendra Cave is another addition. This large limestone cave is locally known as the "House of Bats". The place is a 2-hour walk from downtown Pokhara. Don't forget to bring a torch in order to see stalactites, stalagmites as well as the dreadful looking bats.

Lunch at hotel.

Evening leisure for own activities.

Dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 05

Pokhara / Tansen (Palpa)

Breakfast at hotel.

After breakfast drive to **Tansen** on the Siddhartha Highway, with excellent scenery along the highway.

Tasen Durbar - This former Palace of the provincial governor was built in the Rana style and is now a government office. It has an impressive but run-down eastern gate called **Baggi Dhoka** or **Mul Dhoka**. Outside the gate is a public square called Sitalpati.

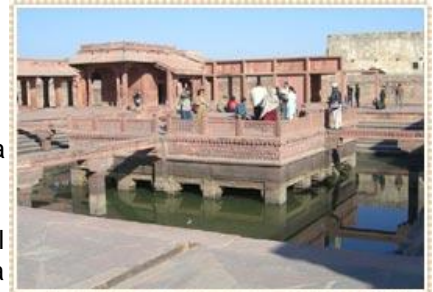
On arrival at Palpa transfer to the hotel.

Check in at hotel.

Lunch at hotel.

After lunch sightseeing of the **important places** and **enjoy the sunset over the Himalaya's**.

Dinner and over-night stay at Hotel.





DAY 06

Tansen / Lumbini

Breakfast at hotel.

After breakfast drive to Lumbini. On arrival transfer to the hotel.

Lunch at hotel.

After lunch proceed on a sight seeing tour of Lumbini – the most important among them is to visit the **Birth place of Lord Buddha** – which is again a world heritage site.

Dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 07

Lumbini / Chitwan

Breakfast at hotel.

Then Drive to **Royal Chitwan National Park** for an exclusive jungle safari.

The Royal Chitwan National Park (932 sq km) to the southwest of Kathmandu and Bharatpur airport adjoining the park is a mere 25 minute flight away and the most popular safari destination. More than 43 species of animals are found in Chitwan. Other thrills are canoe rides on the Jungle River, nature walks, bird watching excursions, elephant bathing in the river, Tharu cultural village tour, visit the Elephant Breeding Centre, Gharial Breeding & Conservation Centre etc.

Upon arrival transfer to Jungle Resort.

Lunch at Resort.

In the late afternoon, the guests will be taken for a **jungle safari on an Elephant back** so that they can penetrate deep into the jungle for viewing and photographing wildlife or a jungle walk is organized to experience the abundant bird life and the flora & fauna of the park. If you are lucky, you may see the elusive Royal Bengal Tiger both on nature walk as well as on elephant safari.

A hearty meal of continental or Nepalese cuisine will be served in the evening around the campfire.

Tharu Cultural Show Programs or Slide Presentation in the evening.

Dinner and Overnight at Jungle Resort.



DAY 08



Chitwan

Breakfast at hotel.

After breakfast day at leisure for own activities.

Lunch at hotel.

Late evening visit the **Elephant Breeding Centre, Jungle walk and Fishing in river or bird watching, Cultural Programme, Slide Presentation.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 09

Chitwan / Nagarkot

Breakfast at Jungle Resort.

Then drive to **Nagarkot** (32 km / 01 hrs) through the windy road situated at 2175 meters above sea level, This is a magnificent place to view the panorama of major peaks of the eastern Himalayan ranges including Mt. Everest on clear days.

En route enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

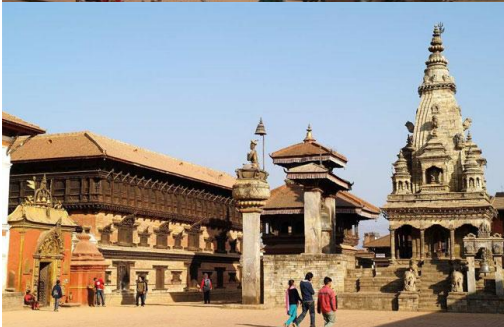
Upon arrival at Nagarkot, transfer to hotel.
